- COPD
- Arthritis

SERVICES WE PROVIDE

Chronic Care Management for Medicare patients with two or more chronic illnesses recognized by Medicare as a potential cause for declining health or increased ER visits or hospitalization.

Transitional Care to help patients transition from the hospital to the home, including assistance with making follow-up appointments, ensuring ordered medications and/or equipment are received, and providing education on symptom management and home recovery.

Annual Wellness Visits: Preventative screenings which are paid for by Medicare without co-pays or out of pocket expenses.
